Driving Directions

Bridgeville St. George Antiochian Church

From Rt. 50 in Bridgeville, turn onto Chartiers Street next to Rite Aid. Turn left at the second street onto Dewey Avenue. Church is located two blocks ahead on the left. Next to the Church is a small house called the education Center. Classes are held in the education center. Parking is on street.

Christ Community Church

Follow West Carson Street (Rt. 51N) into McKees Rocks. Turn left onto Stanhope St. Turn right onto Chartiers Ave. Follow Chartiers Ave. for 1500 feet. Church is on the right.

Dormont Presbyterian Church

Take Rt. 19 North into Dormont. Turn left onto Potomac Ave. Church is 2 blocks ahead on the right.

Emmanuel Lutheran Church

Take Rt. 28 North out of the city. Exit left to Etna. Follow Mt. Royal Blvd. past the Blarney Stone. Church is 500 feet ahead on the right.

First United Methodist Church

From Charleroi, Northwest on Fallowfield towards 1st Street, turn right on 1st. St./PA-88 going North Turn right on PA-88 arrive at 430 W. Main St. *From Canonsburg*, PA-980 becomes PA/519 turn slight right onto Brownlee Road turn left on PA-136 continue to follow PA/136 turn right onto West Main Street. St/136 PA/837 PA/88 arrive on 430 West Main Street.

Montours Presbyterian Church

Take Rt. 60 toward the Pittsburgh Airport. Merge onto Rt. 22/30 toward Imperial. Exit at the Montour Church Rd. interchange. Turn right and proceed up the hill to church on the left.

South Hills Church of the Nazarene

Take Rt. 88 South past the entrance to South Park. Continue for 8/10 of a mile. Stone church on the left across from Brightwood Road.

St. Luke's Lutheran Church

Take Rt. 19 South into West View. After passing Isaly's on the left turn left onto Center Avenue. Drive to the top of the hill and under the Ridgewood Avenue overpass. Church is immediately on the right. Turn into the alley to find the parking lot on the right. Enter at the corner of lot.

Wilson Presbyterian Church

From Glassport, turn onto Glassport Bridge. Continue on Clairton Bridge. Turn left on PA-837/State Street/ N. State Street. Turn right at PA-885/Walnut Avenue. Turn left on N. 4th Street. — *From South Park*, Take PA-885. Continue on 885 to 4th Street.
